## Rush Lake Trek and Climbing the Rush Peak(5,098m)

2011 proved to be a successful year for trekking to the Rush Lake and the Peak. 4 (four) groups from Saiyu Travel were materialized and 3 (three) of the four could reach the Rush peak and enjoyed the views of K2 (8611 m) from the top.

Diversifying the trekking tours to the different areas of Northern Pakistan, Saiyu-Japan along with Saiyah-Pakistan decided to undertake the challenging routes in the remote areas to provide best views to its valuable clients and to fulfill the urge of adventure tours in the Karakorum, Himalayas and Hindukush.

Rush lake trek is comparatively easy but well rewarded with the views of amazing clusters of several peaks of Karakorum from the Rush peak including that of K2.

The trek starts from the Hopper village in Nagar Valley, which can be reached by jeeps from Karakoram highway, very few trekking parties

tend to visit the remote valleys of Nagar, particularly the Rush trek, so promoting this trek is also like helping the porters and other related people of the area. During the trek we cross over the Hooper and Barpu glaciers and climb along moraine to the lake at 4700 m. A few hours climb to the nearby Rush peak (5098 m) offers views of Hisper, Biafo glaciers and K2 on a clear day.
